OUR PROGRAMS

Emergency Shelter

In partnership with BC Housing, our emergency shelter offers a safe, welcoming space for up to 21 people year-round. Guests receive essentials—warm beds, healthy meals, showers, and laundry—along with caring support, activities, and one-on-one help with employment, income assistance, and finding permanent housing.

Homeless Encampment Action Response Temporary Housing

HEARTH is a BC Housing initiative that provides emergency shelter and support for individuals living in downtown encampments. At the ARC, 32 shelter beds are available to meet immediate needs, with guests accessing the full range of shelter services.

Transitional Housing

The ARC provides 41 transitional housing beds for guests moving out of shelter programs who continue to experience housing insecurity. THP offers an affordable, safe, and supportive living environment where individuals work with caseworkers to navigate barriers and pursue long-term housing in the community. A housing navigator also provides follow-up support to help guests successfully transition into their new homes.

Emergency Weather Response

The ARC serves as the city's primary Emergency Weather Response site, providing 30 additional shelter spaces between November and March during extreme winter weather. When alerts are activated, our chapel and community dining room open so guests can come in from the cold, stay overnight, and receive dinner and breakfast.
